Crime / Safety



- Greater Shepparton has less rape, less aggravated burglary, less theft of cars, less deception and less handling of stolen goods than Victoria as a whole.
- Overall crime / head population reduced 2001 2004.
- Small decrease (1.1%) in crime noted in Greater Shepparton in 2003-2004. Less than Victoria's decrease (7.3%)
- Community perception of crime suggests that people, overall, feel "less safe" despite the real decrease in the crime rate.

Community Research



- Population increasing by 1.9% pa
- By 2031, 28% of the population > 60 years
- Indigenous population 5,000 plus
 - lower school retention rates Yr 8/9 Yr 12
 - high unemployment
 - overall lower levels of community engagement
- Fewer GS students complete Yr 12 (25%) than for Victoria (40%)
- Fewer GS people have technical and university qualifications than for Victoria

Some of the Challenges



Greater Shepparton needs to

- Assist all to become better qualified
- Assist migrants to speak English
- Keep and attract qualified young people
- Assist sole parents with qualifications, part time work and family support
- Involve Koori and immigrant communities
- Further reduce crime and unintentional accidents

- Multifaith, Ifta, dinner to be an annual event
- Koori Court, reoffend rates down by 12.5%
 - National Award
- Indigenous Enterprise Partnerships going to be established in Shepparton
- GS community strengthening initiatives
- Youth development programs
