Communities That Care (CTC: www.communitiesthatcare.org.au) is a five phase community development process that assists local community services to align with evidence-based prevention practices. Randomised USA trials and Australian evaluations reveal that CTC reduces adolescent problems such as substance use and antisocial behaviour across large populations. This workshop will bring together researchers and practitioners to develop a strategy for CTC to assist communities to achieve injury prevention and community safety outcomes.
